

FRANK H. WOODS TELEPHONE PIONEER ASSOCIATION FUND

- Amount:** \$1,003.42
Eligibility: Physically or mentally disabled persons in Lincoln or Lancaster County, Nebraska
Criteria: Non-profit agencies in Lincoln and Lancaster County who serve individuals with physical or mental disabilities may apply

The Frank H. Woods Telephone Pioneer Association Fund was created in 1982 to honor the life of Frank H. Woods.

The Fund was established to provide grants to non-profit agencies to purchase communications and other types of adaptive devices designed to assist physically or mentally disabled persons.

CRITERIA

1. Individual in need of adaptive equipment must reside in Lincoln or Lancaster County, Nebraska.
2. Nonprofit agencies will apply for grants from this fund and agree to purchase the adaptive equipment for which they apply if awarded the grant. This equipment will then be made available for use by the individual identified in the grant application for the life of the equipment, or until the individual no longer needs or wants the equipment (or leaves the service area). In the case that the individual no longer needs or wants the use of said equipment, the non-profit agency will repurpose the equipment for another individual(s).

APPLICATION

Submit a letter/email with the following information to apply for adaptive equipment for an individual:

- Name of the individual in need of adaptive equipment
- Nonprofit name
- Nonprofit employee submitting letter, email address and phone number
- Amount requested (up to \$1,003.42)
- Reason for adaptive equipment need (communications or other types of adaptive devices)

AWARD

The Lincoln Community Foundation will make the final selection of grant recipients.
