**LINCOLN COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AWARDS \$137,400
TO SUPPORT EIGHT NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, February 16, 2012**

The Lincoln Community Foundation recently granted \$137,400 to eight nonprofit organizations. The grants, which range from \$5,000 to \$40,000, are made possible by contributions from the Lincoln Forever Fund and from a number of LCF donor endowment funds. Organizations that received funding include:

The BryanLGH Foundation - \$40,000

Support for new facility to house the Bryan LGH Independence Center comprehensive mental health and substance abuse program.

CASA for Lancaster County - \$10,000

Recruit, train and supervise volunteer court appointed advocates who provide a voice for abused and neglected children under court supervision.

Center for People in Need - \$10,000

Support for the Neighborhood FOOD outreach program providing food to the indigent, homeless and working poor.

Food Bank of Lincoln - \$15,400

Provide backpacks filled with nutritious food and fresh produce to low income children during the summer months.

Interchurch Ministries of Nebraska- \$12,000

Hold a 'Gold Star Families' retreat to provide support and assistance for those who have lost a loved one in military service.

Lincoln Parks Foundation - \$20,000

Design a plan for enhancement, preservation and recreation along the Salt Valley Greenway connecting Pioneers Park and Spring Creek Prairie.

Nebraska Global Fund for Nonprofit IT - \$25,000

Assist nonprofit organizations in strengthening operational capacity through information technology support and assistance.

Voices of Hope - \$5,000

Support of 24-hour advocacy and crisis intervention services for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.
